Bonnie Kelso is a former Smithsonian exhibit designer turned children's book author and illustrator. She enjoys writing funny stories that entertain and educate. Her debut picture book, *NUDI GILL* (2023, Gnome Road Publishing), features a curious snorkeler who almost steps on a nudibranch, sparking a lively conversation about the fascinating life of these colorful but fierce sea creatures. The story tackles the theme of ocean conservation and stewardship in a humorous and non-preachy way.

SEA SMILES is the first in a three book series that combines childhood milestones with fun facts about sea animals. The second book in the series, *SLEEPY SEA*, releases spring 2025 and pairs fascinating and fun facts about sea creatures with the task of learning bedtime routines and falling asleep on one's own. You'll find sharks, walruses, sea otters and more in this clever exploration of unusual, but successful sea animal sleep habits. The third in the series, *SEA SUDS*, releases spring 2026 and pairs learning to bathe with fascinating facts about how sea creatures, such as sea turtles, shrimp, octopuses and others practice hygiene in unique ways.

WONDER OF THE WOODS, releasing September 2024, indulges the senses as a young girl explores her wooded backyard and encounters a variety of animals that are curious about their new visitor. Tails twitch, bodies ripple, and leaves drift. They watch each other from a safe distance. Could the Wonder of the Woods be YOU? Wonders abound as you explore nature in this lyrical picture book about curiosity and harmony.

QUAIL TRAIL, releasing November 2024, takes readers on a desert adventure with a brood of quails while touching on hiking safety protocols. Roxie is an independent-thinking quail chick who just has to find out what's over that hill! Topknot is her bossy troop leader who pecks the fun out of adventures with all her silly rules. When Roxie takes her own path, gets lost along the quail trail and can't remember the special call that will reunite her with her brood, she learns the hard way that a little listening can go a long way. *Quail Trail* is a funny, informational fiction picture book that will engage even

the most reluctant reader. Parents and teachers will appreciate the gentle messaging regarding the importance of listening, self-awareness, and making good choices.

Bonnie holds a Bachelor's of Fine Art from the Rhode Island School of Design. She often conducts live and online art workshops in the Las Vegas area and beyond. She is the proud recipient of many Nevada Arts Council grants and is on their roster of teaching artists for schools and communities.

Bonnie is the 2021 winner for the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators (SCBWI) Karen Cushman Late Bloomers Award for her historical chapter book, JOHNNY BELL BAKER AND THE COAL MINE. She volunteers for her regional SCBWI Nevada chapter as the Illustrator Coordinator.

An artist and muralist, Bonnie's work is on a parking garage, in a library, in a community center, on banners and at other public places in Southern Nevada.

Bonnie has traveled around the world twice! She is an avid outdoors enthusiast and loves wandering around the desert with her family in Las Vegas, NV.

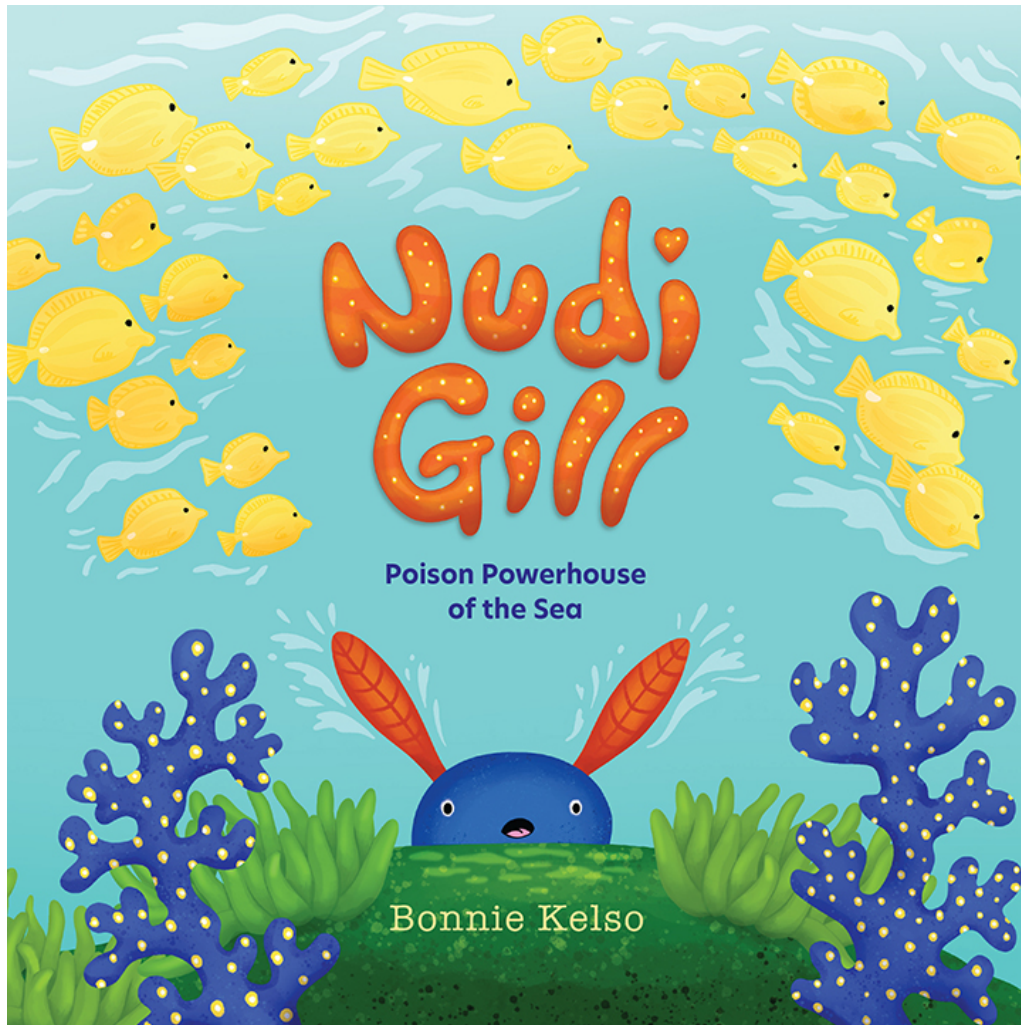

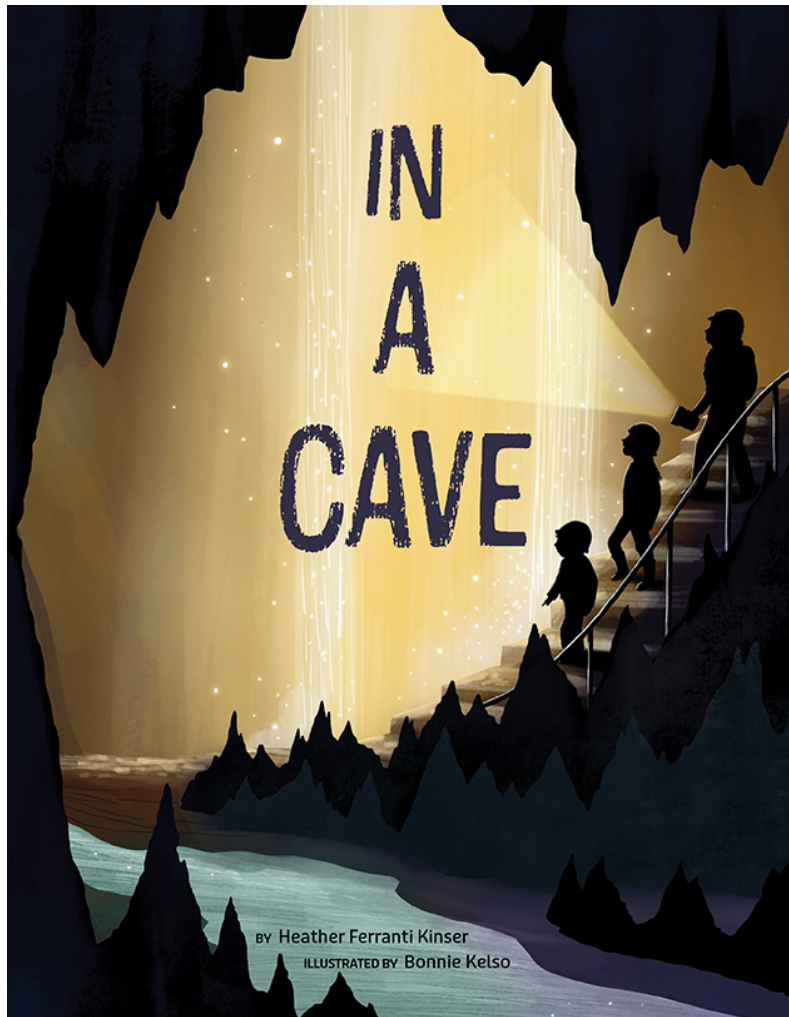


Nudi Gill: Poison Powerhouse of the Sea *(April 4, 2023)*

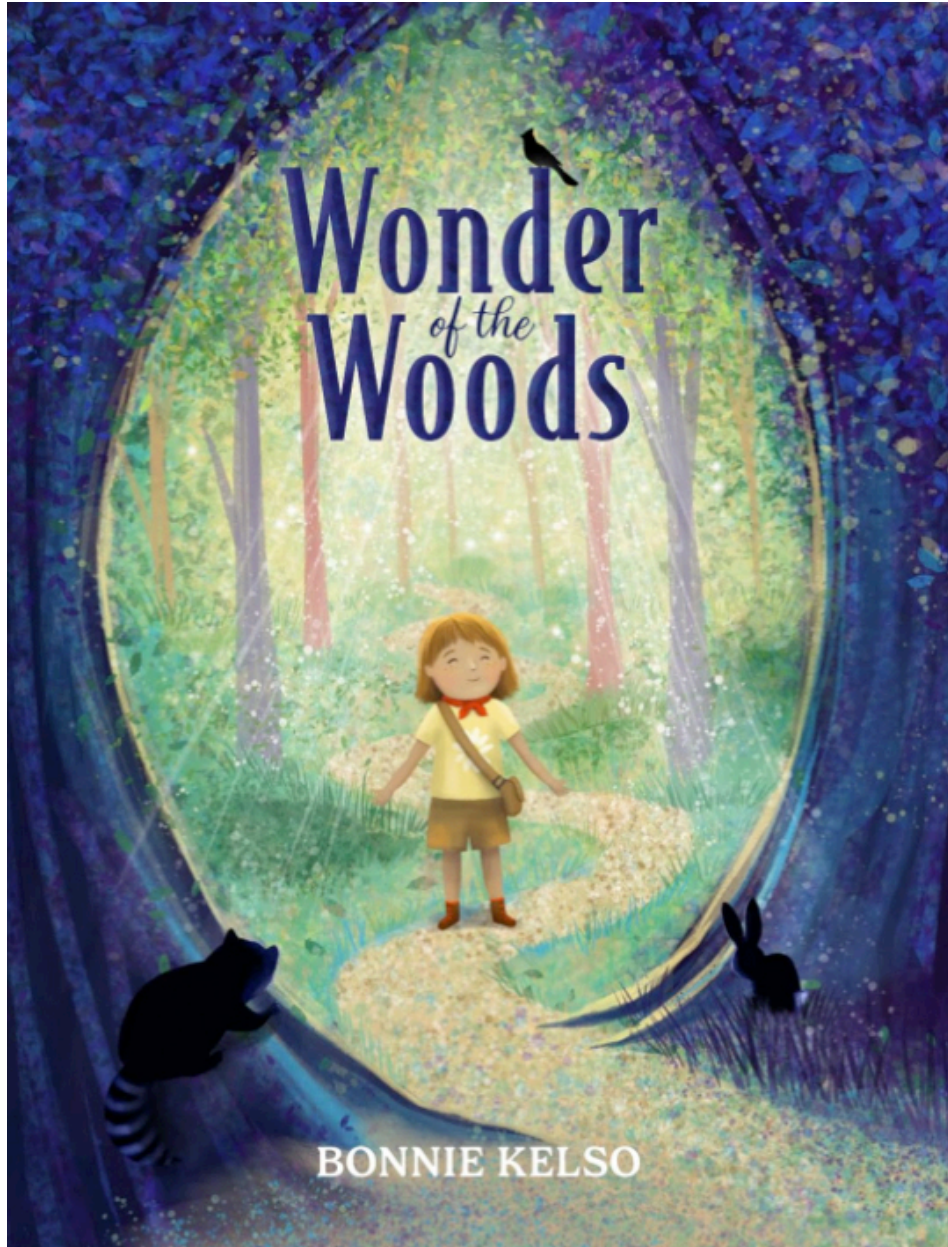


Sea Smiles (February 13, 2024)
