




Sea Animal Name:

- can remove own dead cells


Sea Animal Name:

Hygiene facts:

- needs help removing parasites
- rests in cleaning stations
- lets fish pick parasites from body

Beluga whale



Hygiene facts:

- needs to remove dead skin cells
- can remove own dead skin
- rolls on pebbles to exfoliate

Clown fish



Hygiene facts:

- needs stinging mucus to protect body
- rubs on anemone to acquire mucus
- sometimes eats poop by mistake


Sea Animal Name:
Shrimp



Hygiene facts:

- sheds exoskeleton to stay healthy
- can molt every 3-4 weeks
- does not require help when molting

Shark



Hygiene facts:

- needs help removing parasites
- uses cleaning stations
- does not attack fish who are cleaning


